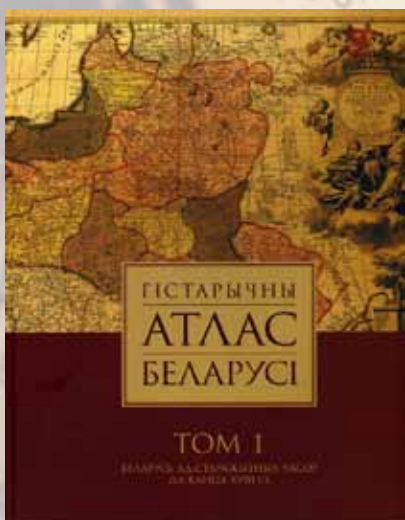

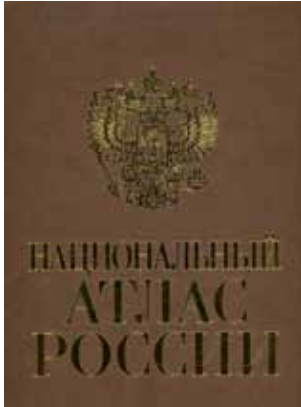




## **Siberia. An Atlas of Asian Russia**
